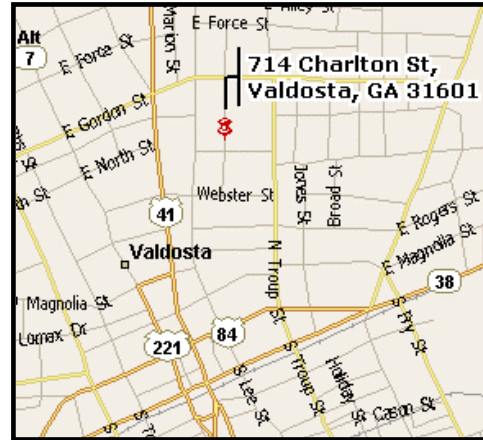

HOMELESS ASSISTANCE

SHELTER

New Horizons Homeless Shelter is for Single Women, Single Women with Children, Single Males with Children, and Husband and Wife with Children. All children must be under the age of 18 years old. Husband and Wife must provide marriage certificate.

The Shelter is open Mon.-Fri from 4:30pm-9:30am. Client must leave their dorms between 9:30am until 4:30pm. Clients are offered 2-meals a day and have a option to eat at the soup. Sat-Sun clients are allowed to remain in shelter dorms all day including holidays. Clients are offered 3-meals a day. Clients are required to follow all rules and guidelines of the shelter upon entering and will be given a handbook during initial intake. Random Drug Testing is done regularly.

Homeless Verification must be obtained before entering into the shelter. Homeless verification consists of one of the following:

- Formal Eviction Notice
- Two letters from family members or friends stating that a person can no longer reside in household. The letters must state why a person is being evicted and include name, phone number, and address of the individual that is evicting.

- Verification from another shelter you recently resided at.
- Verification from an organization that is aware of client's homelessness (ex: DFCS).

For Single Males, New Horizons refer clients to the Salvation Army (3 night stay, 2-meals) with a police clearance

FOOD/CLOTHING

Lamp New Horizons provides transient food for clients that are homeless and living on the street.

Clients must provide verification of residing at the Salvation Army or a police statement that includes where client is residing (streets, in the woods, etc.).

BUS TICKETS

New Horizons provide bus tickets only in the state of Georgia to another shelter. New Horizons will have to have verification either faxed or e-mailed from the shelter before a client is provided a bus ticket. Client must also provide ID, S.S. card.

Clients must provide homeless verification consisting of one of the following:

- Verification from another shelter (Salvation Army)
- Release from a 30-day institution (prison, jail, hospital, etc.)

This process may take 2-3 days before a client is provided with a bus ticket. Approved client's are offered the option to reside at NH or referred to the Salvation Army.

DAYCENTER

New Horizons Day Center offers numerous supportive services such as; assistance with showering, laundry, I.D., Birth certificate, Social Security Card, computer use, phone, fax, assistance with employment, and resume writing.
